

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING WISCONSIN DO NOT CALL

Our goal at CenturyLink is to offer products that meet your communication needs and to provide timely information regarding changes or events that could affect your service. The information provided below is to keep you informed regarding the Wisconsin Do Not Call Program.

Signing up identifies you as someone who does not wish to receive telemarketing calls. It's free and available for residential telephone customers in Wisconsin. Your number will remain on the List for two years. Adding your home or mobile phone numbers to the List will help reduce (but not eliminate) telemarketing calls.

Consumers can sign up 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and 365 days a year: By visiting the Wisconsin No Call List website online at <https://nocall.wisconsin.gov/web/registration.asp> or by calling 1-866-9NO-CALL (1-866-966-2255) toll-free in Wisconsin. The date you sign up determines the date when telemarketing calls should decrease. The updated No Call List is given to registered telemarketers quarterly. Therefore, it may take 30 to 120 days for your number to get to telemarketers.
